

The format of the paper is A4, the margins are 2.5cm from top and bottom and 2cm from the left and right. The abstract shall be written in English using Arial or DejaVu Sans 12pt. Please consider that your abstract should be readable as PDF on the screen of a smartphone without zoom. When useful, include a table of contents graphics (TOC) or an eye-catcher similar to the one below.



The line spacing is 1.15 and there is one empty line separating all Figures and all paragraphs for better readability. The TOC should be understandable without Figure caption. The total length of the abstract is limited to one page. Abstracts exceeding this limit will not be considered. References to the literature shall use the example formats for books [1], papers [2], or a thesis [3]. If available, include a hyperlink to the corresponding work, in particular, if the paper is essential for your talk or summarizes the results that you want to present.

Please submit your abstract as PDF by e-mail to png2026@ipfdd.de. Filename is of form Author_Institute_Talk.pdf where “Talk” could be replaced by “Poster” or “Invited”, if appropriate. Make sure that you include the correct email in the abstract. We will use this email for all correspondence. You can expect notification of acceptance within 14 days after the abstract deadline. **The registration deadline will be 14 days after the abstract acceptance notification. You must register in time. Otherwise, your contribution will be removed from the program.** If you require an early acceptance of your abstract due to funding reasons, please specify this in the subject of your email at submission. We will not correct misprints or other errors of your abstracts. We may notify you in some cases, but it is the task of the authors to provide a correct abstract.
